PURPOSE & NATURE OF JOB

The City of Aztec has identified enhancements to be done at Minium Park (Projects 1-3), Memorial Rose Garden (Projects 4-6), and Rio Animas Park (Alternate Projects 1-3):

Project 1. Splash & Play Shade Structures

- Install two shade structures at Splash Park main entrance.
- Concrete slabs at base of shade structures.

Project 2. Playground Benches

Project 3. Landscaping

- Clear landscape area.
- Lay weed barrier.
- Lay and compact crusher fines

Project 4. Redesign and Landscaping of Rose Garden

- Clear vegetation in Zones A-C
- Re-design irrigation system
- Plant rose bushes (Locations 1-3)
- Plant three (3) new trees
- Lay weed barrier in Zones A-C
- Lay crusher fines in Zones A-C
- Install lighting system at corners of garden (Zones B & C)

Project 5. Landscaping

- Clear and level
- Extend irrigation system for tree locations
- Plant trees
- Lay weed barrier
- Xeriscape (gravel and/or cobble)

Project 6. RV Dump Station Drive Pad

- Excavate and frame drive pad
- Pour and surface concrete pad

Alternate 1. Picnic Tables

- Clear vegetation
- Assemble picnic tables
- Install picnic tables into concrete footers
- Install trash can at each location
- Mulch trail paths to picnic tables

Alternate 2. Input Ramp

- Clear vegetation
- Lay gravel along ramp
- Lay cobble along border of ramp

Alternate 3. Parking Lot Graveling

- Clear vegetation
- Lay and spread gravel

Install two (2) trash cans

Under the general direction of the YCC Coordinator this position performs manual labor.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

Performs a variety of general labor and construction tasks. This position may utilize but is not limited to cordless drill, wrenches, concrete tools - floats, trowels, shovels, wheelbarrow, shovels, brooms, and other miscellaneous tools.

Crew Leader shall be responsible for completing evaluations on assigned YCC Members.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

Physical Demands:	Effort is prolonged and frequent. Strain may be extended in duration. Effort involves heavy lifting (50 – 80 lbs), pushing, and pulling with excessive crouching, stooping or lying in prone position. Could involve intense strain on sight and hearing. High manual dexterity is required.
Hazards:	Recurring conditions which involve change of injury. Regular travel in vehicle may be part of this position.
