
A. Understanding Energy: Don't Fear the Frack

- George Sharpe provided a Video and PowerPoint presentation about energy types, environmental issues and pros on the fossil fuels
- Solar and Wind energy not being built fast enough and fossil fuel will be needed for a long time
- He explained the process of fracking and explained that the San Juan Basin is a Natural Gas Basin
- The process of fracking is the optimization of two old processes and significantly reduces impact on land and environment; the process never comes in contact with the ground water; it has not been shown to create earthquakes

- There were varying opinions on the subject of natural gas and the environmental impact
