He also mentioned that the best candidate for the City Manager position had an incident back in early 2000 where he and others were accused of sexual harassment based upon retaliatory practices with job promotions and job assignments, he has concerns but at the same time he has been given more than one second chance and he is grateful and he is not the same person he was when he was younger. He mentioned that Mr. Eckert has been very open and honest with them about his past.
