VIII. COMMISSIONER, CITY MANAGER, DEPARTMENT REPORTS

City Manager Paul Eckert attended Chamber of Commerce Board Meeting they are looking forward to helping businesses in the community. Commissioner Lewis attended San Juan water commission meeting they had a report on Lake Mead and Lake Powell same as last meeting. Next year lower states will have to reduce their water use, including the Republic of Mexico.

Mayor Victor Snover thanked everyone involved in the commission meeting and for covering for him. School is back in session show more caution now that there will be more traffic and kids

Chief Mike Heal mentioned the schools reopening, and that officers will be out with issuing citations for people that are speeding.

Community Development Director Steven Saavedra thanked everyone for attending the EA picnic. He recognized Angela Watkins for doing great things at the Library. There will be an upcoming EDAB meeting next week one topic will be Economic Development of Cannabis.

Steve Morse reported workers put in over 1000 ft. of water pipes in two weeks, and will move to sewer pipes once that is complete. Production pipe #5 at the water plant is moving along, hoping to have the pump in and installed next month. He mentioned that NM 173 is at the DOT for review, they had some comments about design. McWilliams Road was awarded to TRC, he expects them to be out there within the next week or so to begin the project. Ditch Pump only had one bid so it was closed and reopened in hopes of getting more bids. He had a meeting with Russ Florez about Ruins Road and traffic control for that road project. A water leak on Ancient Trails was currently being repaired by a crew of five.
