Mayor Pro-Tem inquired about the bladder tank cover project; Finance Director Anthony Bolling stated that there is \$350,000 of ARPA money allocated for that. It was mentioned that it will be good to have a good grant writer on staff, finance is currently hiring someone to be more focused on the grants.

A. Resolution 2022-1272 Authorizing The Use of Coronavirus State and Local Recovery Funds

Finance Director Anthony Bolling stated that this resolution is to use some of the Funds that were allocated from the ARP to give the employees a onetime premium pay bonus in February. The city is going to give out the premium pay dependent on the hours worked and the time employed with the City. Depending on the hours and time worked from January 1, 2021 and January 1, 2022 will be the amount they receive. This will exclude Commission, City Manager and Volunteers. City Attorney Steve Murphy recommended tabling the resolution to make some changes to the language pertaining to the pay or make the amendments tonight and commission can make the decision to approve the resolution as amended.
