The Community Development Director Andrew DiCamillo updated the commission that the Aztec Downtown Association is moving forward, they are officially a 501c3.

Electric Director John Wheeler had updates for the commission regarding;

- Ancient Trails Substation

- Tap for 345-line design and cost
- Hartman Park lighting

Commissioner Crowley inquired about the projects from the original list that John had presented and asked for an update on the recent outages in Aztec. Mayor Pro-Tem asked about the possibility of connecting to Farmington's 115 kV line and requested figures for that option, as well as for the 345 kV line. He also expressed interest in exploring the possibility of acquiring generators for the city.


Project Manager Jeric Jaramillo had updates on the current projects;

- Arterial Phase III


Mayor Pro-Tem is pleased that repairs are finally underway on the money-saving bridge.

MOVED by Mayor Pro-Tem George and SECONDED by Commissioner King to adjourn the meeting at 6:20 pm


